Tutor Requirements for Employment

May 2006

Introduction

At the moment, the National School of Aesthetics has a waiting list of people seeking employment as tutors with the school. When a position becomes available, we go through the list of people we have and interview them.

Qualifications Required

To be a beauty therapy tutor at the National School of Aesthetics, you are required to hold one or more groups of the following:

- International Therapy Examination Council
 - Under the old system, you would be expected to hold:
 - Aestheticienne Diploma; and
 - Diploma in Physiatrics; and
 - Diploma in Electrology
 - Under the new system, you would be expected to hold:
 - Diploma for Beauty Specialists; and
 - Diploma in Facial Electrical Treatments; and
 - Diploma in Body Treatments; and
 - Diploma in Epilation
- Confederation of International Beauty Therapy and Cosmetology
 - Aesthetics Treatment Diploma; and
 - Body Therapy Diploma; and
 - Electrical Epilation Diploma
- CIDESCO
 - Diploma in Beauty Therapy; and
 - One of the electrology diplomas as listed above.

To be a spa therapy tutor at the National School of Aesthetics, you are required to hold relevant qualifications as determined by the Board of Directors and be a fully-qualified beauty therapist, where applicable.

To be a nail technology tutor at the National School of Aesthetics, you are required to hold relevant qualifications as determined by the Board of Directors. These are usually either international qualifications from the governing bodies listed above or an NZQA-Approved equivalent.

For all of these positions, we expect you to hold a Certificate in Adult Teaching. If you do not hold this at the time of your application, and if your application is successful, we will expect you to undertake and gain this qualification.

In addition, if you do not hold CIDESCO and are applying for a beauty therapy or spa therapies job, you may be required to undertake the CIDESCO Post-Graduate Diploma in Beauty Therapy.

You will also be expected to be familiar with the products we use, and this will be taught to you once you join the team.

Brief List of Responsibilities

Requirements for job

A successful applicant should possess:

- Passion about their industry
- Excellent communication skills
- Excellent people skills
- Good organisational skills
- Excellent work ethic
- Excellent ethics
- An efficient manner
- Ability to work with people from all backgrounds
- Professionalism
- Ability to adapt to various situations and changes
- Previous and continuous employment in the industry
- Ability to teach
- A Certificate in Adult Teaching or equivalent (if you do not hold this, you may need to obtain this once you are employed at the school)
- New Zealand citizenship or permanent residency.
