#### Your Reason(s) for Withdrawing

You are required to give your reason(s) for withdrawing because Government agencies require us to hold information on why a student withdraws and your feedback may help us as an organisation. We reserve the right to refuse your reason if there is no evidence of your claim or if it contradicts evidence from other sources.

#### Withdrawal due to Medical Reasons

You will need to supply a valid medical certificate from a registered medical practitioner stating, in his or her opinion, you are no longer medically able to complete the programme. Your medical certificate must be supplied with this form.

If you withdraw due to medical reasons, you should be able to prove to government agencies and education providers you may wish to enrol with in the future that you withdrew from our programme due to legitimate medical reasons.

#### You cannot claim another reason (i.e. other) if your withdrawal is due to a medical reason.

## Fees Due and Refunds

Please be aware you may not be eligible for a refund or may owe the school a portion of or your entire programme fee, depending on when you withdraw. If you withdraw within the refund period, you must contact us for a Public Trust Refund Form, and you must complete this Public Trust Refund Form with your Withdrawal Form.

If we have to pursue you to withdraw, or if your withdrawal is not complete the first time around, we reserve the right to charge you for our time and resources used. See <u>www.nasa.co.nz/fees/</u> for our billing rates.

#### Your Withdrawal and StudyLink

If you have a student loan and/or allowance, and you are withdrawing from your programme, you are legally required to inform StudyLink you have left your programme. We are also required by law to let them know you have withdrawn.

#### **Re-Enrolling at a Later Date**

In many cases, if you withdraw, you will not be eligible for re-enrolment in another programme with us.

If the owners allow you to re-enrol at a later date due to documented medical illness or another reason, you must:

- Withdraw in writing from the programme you are currently enrolled in using this form; and
- Re-enrol using an up-to-date enrolment form into the programme you wish to enrol in; and
- Provide evidence you are medically fit to attend the programme.

You must repay your fees and any additional changes in requirements (i.e. different uniform, up-to-date textbooks, etc).
